

## Order

Sanction of the Governor of Haryana is hereby accorded to the grant of reimbursement of fees to SC students studying in Polytechnic/Engg. courses in any of the AICTE/State Board approved Institutes Under SCSP amounting to Rs **7,48,500/-** (Rs. Seven lacs Forty Eight Thousand Five Hundred only) as per details given below subject to following conditions. However in the first instance only 25% of sanctioned payment is to be released:-

**Conditions:-**

1. Amount of tuition fee is to be paid to SC students admitted through central counseling having parent income between 1.00 lacs to 2.40 lac.
2. No amount of tuition fee is to be paid to SC students having parent income above 2.40 lac.
3. The maximum ceiling of fee reimbursable for Diploma programmes has been kept as Rs. 20000/-  
The condition would be reimbursement of actual tuition fee or Rs. 20000/-, whatsoever is less. (All the institutions have to ensure that only tuition fee component per annum as per tuition fee fixed by SFC for self financing Instt. By state Govt. for Govt. Instts./Aid-ed Instts. is to be reimbursed ).
4. The SC student must have made an application in the prescribed format to the institution concerned. The application is to be countersigned by head of Institute certifying the information filled in. This application is to be submitted to the institution releasing payment and not to this office.
5. The students must have been admitted in batch of session 2007-08/2008-09/2009-10 and studying in current session 2009-10
6. Students seeking this reimbursement have not claimed the fee reimbursement from any other Government/Government funded department/agency.
7. At the time of reimbursement students continuous to be enrolled with the Institution and has been promoted to next class.

8. UC is to be submitted by the Principal of concerned Government Polytechnic who has been authorized to make payment by this office. Principal of concerned Government Polytechnic shall maintain a consolidated record in a separate register regarding disbursement/reimbursement of the tuition fee under the scheme with the appended signatures of the claimants from respective head of the Institutions.
9. The Principal of Govt. Poly authorized to release payment will ensure that cheque of payment is handed-over directly to the said students. However in case the institutes gives an undertaking that no fee charge from SC students and same shall be released in favour of that institution.
10. All other conditions as explicitly mentioned in the schemes
11. It is specifically mentioned that the responsibility for authentication/ verification of submitted data/documents/fulfillment of guidelines lies with the head of Institution where student is admitted.
12. The institutions have to supply the SC students list and certificate of 80% attendance of the SC students to be sent to the concerned Disbursing Institute on quarterly basis.
13. The institutions have to get open the accounts in the name of concerned SC students in the nearby Post Office/bank for reimbursement of fee directly to the account of the students.
14. 25% of payment shall be released in the first goes in the balance in three equitative installments in current and subsequent semester.

The expenditure is to be debited under the head "2203 Technical Education-789-Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes-96-Reimbursments of fee of SC students-74-Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Plan) 2009-10.
