## Details:

### A **Academic reputation-Total weightage- 25 Marks**

#### **(a)I Pass percentile of last 3 years (10 marks)**

Total No. of students passed in the session 2005-2006 of those admitted in 2002-03 session in First year.

**Note: i)** While ascertaining the passed percentile, the result of only those students will be considered who were legitimately admitted by the State/ Institution during regular admission of that batch. Thereby not including lateral Entry in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester and drop outs, subsequently in 2<sup>nd</sup> semester onwards joining that batch.

ii) The similar information should be provided for two proceeding batches.

iii) The student counted in pass percentage should have completed their degree in four years by passing all papers.

#### **(a) II Merit range of Admissions (10 marks)**

The merit rank in AIEEE/CEET of 7<sup>th</sup> , 31<sup>st</sup> and 53<sup>rd</sup> candidate admitted in the institution in the batch of 60 and 10<sup>th</sup> , 46<sup>th</sup> and 80<sup>th</sup> in the batch of 90 and similarly 13<sup>th</sup>, 61<sup>st</sup> and 107<sup>th</sup> in the batch of 120, be considered, branch wise, for the session 2004-05,2005-06 & 2006-07. The percentage of pass marks of these candidates in qualifying exam should also be considered in the event of admission made by the institution at their own level in management Quota seats/ left over/ vacant/ unfilled seats.

#### **(a)III Extension activity (5 marks)**

Total number of courses conducted for industries / Govt. officers other than faculty and its associated registration should be considered.

## **B Accreditation by NBA**

Since the accreditation is one of the eligibility condition and the proposals were decided to be considered only if the institution was accredited by NBA, so the accreditation was decided to be given bonus marks only. The institute having accreditation in three courses should not be given any marks, but the four courses accredited should be given five bonus marks, whereas five courses be given 10 marks and so on.

## **C Placement record of last 3 Years (10 marks)**

It was decided to consider the placement through campus interview for the last 3 years i.e. student passing in the session 2003-04, 2004-05 & 2005-06. Percentage placement will be considered i.e. total No. of offer received (students placed) divided by total No. of student available for placement. This information be considered branch wise. The definite information regarding name of company, date of interview, mode of interview etc. should be made available alongwith documentary proof.

## **D Cadre Ratio as stipulated by AICTE-(10 marks)**

The committee decided as under:

- The institution fulfilling minimum requirement of AICTE, for student teacher ratio of 1:15 be given as 3 marks and the institution meeting with the richer norms than minimum should be given 5 marks.
- The institution meeting the cadre ratio prescribed by AICTE as 1:2:6, should be given 3 marks and institution having more professor than minimum norms should be given 5 marks.
- Similar weightage will be given for associate professor.

**Note:** The above ratio will be calculated on the sanctioned intake of the institution and not for student as on roll.

**E Academic achievements of the faculty (15 marks)**

The committee decided to consider the No. of Research Papers published, Book Written, Patent Registered by the faculty members in the relevant field after joining that particular institution.

**F Quality & merit in selection of students & teachers (10 marks)**

Since the merit range of admission of student has already been considered and given due weightage at point 2.1(a) II, so the Committee decided to consider the merit in selection of teachers only. The number of lecturers selected in the institution having M.E./ M.Tech/ PG Degree i.e. higher than the prescribed AICTE norms, at the time of recruitment, will be given higher marks.

**G Adequacy of infrastructure for example Library, equipment, accommodation for academic activities. (10 Marks)**

The Committee decided to give more weightage to the institution fulfilling norms and standard over and above the minimum norms & standard prescribed by the AICTE/ affiliating University for equipment

**H&J Quality of institutional management & Responsiveness and effectiveness of the administrative structure (10 Marks)**

The committee decided to give weightage of five marks to the students associated in decision making process i.e. students feed back regarding teaching / institution and five marks to teachers involvement in decision making i.e. delegation of powers by the institution to Director-Principal and HOD/Deans/ Chairman of Department/ faculty.

**I Financial resources provided by the management/ State Govt., as the case may be, for the development of Institution. (10 Marks)**

The committee decided to give weightage to the capital assets (excluding cost of land) as on 31.3.2006, as per the balance sheet duly signed by Chartered Accountant supplied by the institution.

**K Motivation and involvement of faculty in the promotion of innovative reforms (10 marks)**

The committee decided to give weightage for the achievements for the last three years i.e. for the session 2003-04,2004-05 and 2005-06 as under:

- AICTE projects undertaken by the faculty
- Total value of consultancy projects / revenue generated.
- Percentage of revenue generated retained by the faculty members.
- Full time faculty sponsored by the institute in PG program with full pay.
- No. of regular faculty sponsored by the institute for doctorate programme with full pay
- The faculty deputed to attend the National / international conference with full expenditure by the Institute.
