

**Eligibility Qualification for admission to various technical courses as prescribed by AICTE/ PCI/ Council of Architecture/ Affiliating University/ State Board of Technical Education as the case may be, is adopted by SCBH. However, the institutions asking higher percentage in terms of marks only will be permitted to do so.**

**Minimum Academic Qualification for:**

**MCA:**

**Should be a pass in any recognized Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years' duration in any discipline with Mathematics at 10 + 2 level.**

Or

**Should be a pass in any recognized Bachelor's Degree of minimum 3 years' duration in any discipline with Mathematics / Statistics as one of the subjects.**

Or

**Should be a pass in BCA Degree of minimum three years duration from a recognized University**

**Note:**

1. The minimum eligibility qualification in case of **Lingaya's Institute of Management & Technology, Faridabad** is 50% marks in Graduation. Whereas in case of **Faridabad Institute of Technology**, Faridabad it is 55% marks.
2. Mere possession of the prescribed minimum academic qualifications does not entitle a candidate for admission to MCA course. Candidates would be required to fulfill other conditions as spelt out in the Admission Brochure.
3. Candidates, who are appearing in the qualifying examination this year and are expecting to pass the same, can also compete for counseling for MCA., but they would be considered for admission, if they fulfill minimum eligibility criteria.
4. Eligibility shall be seen on the day of counseling i.e. a candidate may not be eligible on the 1st day of counseling but may be eligible on subsequent days of counseling due to what- so-ever reasons. He/she shall be considered for counseling on the day he/she proves his/her eligibility against the available seats at that point of time.
5. Candidates having passed Mathematics/ Statistics in one semester / in one year (as the case may be) shall be considered eligible.
