Subject: Guidelines for the reappear students of 1st & 2nd semesters who were admitted/ sought re-admission in 2008 and are appearing as reappear candidates in HSBTE exam Nov/Dec, 09.

The student admitted/ sought re-admission in 2008 and have failed in 1st & 2nd semester were allowed to attend regular classes of 3rd semester vide office order no. 661/HSBTE dt. 19.10.09 and will be appearing in the subjects in which they were failed in 1st & 2nd semester, as reappear candidates in subjective exam/ practical exam, as the case may be, in HSBTE exam Nov/Dec, 09. The guidelines for these reappear students admitted in 2008 will be followed as under:

Sr. No.	Description	Guidelines to be followed
1.	PCA Forms	To be filled as per notified dates.
2.	Examination for failed students admitted/ sought re-admission in 2008 who could not obtain minimum 30% marks in individual subject	The student may appear in HSBTE Exam Nov/Dec,09 as re-appear candidate in both the subjective & the practical exam of a subject having both the components i.e. theory & practical and may appear in the practical exam of the subject having only practical component.
3.	The students admitted/ sought re-admission in 2008 who could not obtain the requisite secure of 40% marks in aggregate of all the subjects and have failed	The student may appear as re-appear candidate in the subjective & practical exam of all the subjects to be held in Nov/Dec, 2009.
4.	Declaration of result	(a) The marks obtained in objective & subjective exams of a subject in previous examinations will be replaced by the marks obtained in the subjective paper of that subject in re-appear exam to be held in Nov./ Dec.' 09, if marks are higher. (b) The marks obtained in practical exam of a subject in previous examinations will be replaced by the marks obtained in the practical exam of that subject in re-appear exam to be held in Nov./ Dec.' 09, if marks are higher.
5.	Minimum Pass Marks	To declare the student pass, both the conditions i.e. to obtain minimum 30% marks in aggregate of all the components of a individual subject and to obtain minimum 40% marks in aggregate of all the subjects, already notified, will remain the same.

It is requested, that the above guidelines may be brought to the notice of all the staff members & the students immediately for strict compliance of the same.
